- Button Cystostomy – a safe and easy method to access the bladder in selected patients with neuropathic bladder?
- Infection in a VP shunt after revision: what is best management?
- Highlighting cognitive impairment associated with spina bifida.


Each Case will be given 10-15 minutes for presentation and discussion.
